OCTOBER - PINK



October is Breast Cancer Awareness Month, which is held every year to promote detection and prevention of the disease, which annually affects 2.3 million women worldwide.

5 important facts about breast cancer

- Breast cancer has become the number one type of cancer in women.
- The familial existence of this type of cancer increases the risk of suffering it.
- Men have the same risk factors for developing it as women.
- Obesity and alcohol consumption increase the risk.
- A diet that includes all food groups, physical activity and healthy weight can reduce the incidence of breast cancer by 33% to 50%.

What are the main symptoms of breast cancer?

- A lump or thickening in the breast that feels different from the surrounding tissue.
- A change in the size, shape, or appearance of a breast.
- Changes in the skin over the breast, such as dimpling.
- Recent inversion of the nipple.
- Peeling, loosening of the skin, crusting.
- Redness or small holes in the skin over your breast.

When should I consult a physician?

If you find a lump or other change in your breasts on examination or if you had normal results on a recent mammogram, ask for a consultation with your health care provider.

Talk to your doctor about when to begin breast cancer screening tests and exams, such as clinical breast exams.

The International Black and White Piano Festival celebrated its 27th edition from September 1 to 29 at the Centro Nacional de las Artes (CENART). This year, under the slogan "Y de colores!", the festival reaffirmed its commitment to diversity, inclusion and musical excellence.

One of the most anticipated moments of the 2024 edition was the presentation of Nicholas McCarthy (UK), a world-renowned pianist whose talent and determination have defied the expectations of audiences internationally.

Thanks to the support of The Anglo Arts & Culture, McCarthy, the only pianist born without his right hand to graduate from the Royal College of Music, gave an unforgettable performance on September 8, demonstrating how art can be a powerful tool for inclusion and visibility.

TAF CELEBRATIONS



This day recognizes the essential work of educators around the world. Established by UNESCO and the International Labor Organization in 1994, it highlights the important role that teachers play in society and promotes the improvement of their working conditions and the recognition of their work.

In Mexico, the implementation of the Common Curriculum Framework for Higher Education (MCCEMS) represents a new challenge for teachers, who received express training through virtual courses and diplomas from the Sectoral Coordination of Academic Strengthening of the SEP (COSFAC). The lack of adequate mechanisms to understand the fundamentals of the MCCEMS and its implementation in the classroom has been evident, due to the health emergency situation and the lack of a serious approach by the educational authorities.



The national educational debate focused on primary and secondary education, leaving higher education in the background. This situation is partly due to the division of the teachers' union into state unions and the lack of involvement in broader educational debates.

The absence of a concrete and secure guide for the implementation of the MCCEMS has left teachers without adequate guidance. However, this omission also represents an opportunity for teachers to assume a more active role as intellectuals in the creation of curricula, as proposed by Dr. Angel Diaz Barriga. The curriculum is a fundamental instrument for the intellectual work of teachers, where they can recover their creative imagination and contribute from their experience to the didactic work in the classroom.

The connection between school life and the community is crucial for the effective implementation of the MCCEMS. Teachers must address social issues in the classroom and promote social transformation through active learning and transversality.

In summary, World Teachers' Day is an opportunity to reflect on the challenges facing educators, especially in the context of the implementation of the MCCEMS. Education authorities need to provide the necessary support and training to enable teachers to play their role as intellectuals and contribute to the success of this new curriculum framework.

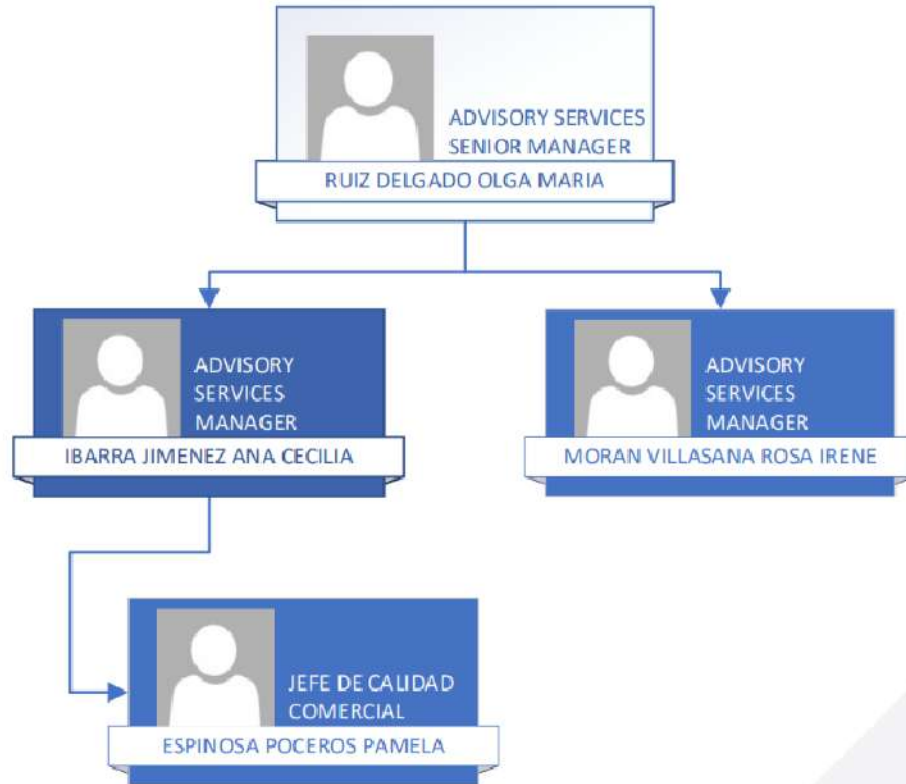
